

# Pack 350 Code of Conduct

1. Cub Scouts will show respect to all adult leaders and parents (even someone else's parents) at all times. This means listening, following directions and no back talk.
2. Cub Scouts will show respect to fellow Scouts. This means behaving at den and pack activities so fellow Cub Scouts can have fun too.
3. Keep your hands and feet to yourself. No pushing, punching, kicking or other inappropriate behavior.
4. No running or jumping around. No climbing on tables or chairs. No horseplay.
5. No interrupting while someone else is speaking. Raise your hand if you want a turn to share.
6. No teasing, using foul language or bad words.
7. No shouting, yelling or disruptive behavior - respect your fellow Scouts and the adults.

## ***"Three Strikes" policy:***

*Strike 1* – Cub Scout receives a verbal warning about his behavior, what he did wrong, why it is wrong and how he should behave.

*Strike 2* – Cub Scout will receive a 5 minute time-out away from the group and group activity.

*Strike 3* – Cub Scout will be removed from the group activity while his parents are called to come pick him up. He will not be allowed at future activities until a meeting with the Cub Scout, his parents, the den leader and the Cubmaster is held to discuss his behavior and how it will be corrected for the future.

## Cub Scout Home Rules

1. Cub Scouts must show respect to their parents and family members at all times.
2. Cub Scouts will be truthful at all times.
3. Cub Scouts will maintain a good relationship with their brothers and sisters.
4. Cub Scouts must help with household chores.
5. Cub Scouts must keep their own room neat and clean.
6. Cub Scouts will not interrupt adult conversations.
7. Cub Scouts will study their schoolwork at school and at home.
8. Cub Scouts must show respect for teachers and peers at all times.

Cub Scouts who have repeated behavior problems or do not obey their parents and follow the home rules will have their Pack membership revoked and will no longer be able to participate in future pack functions.
